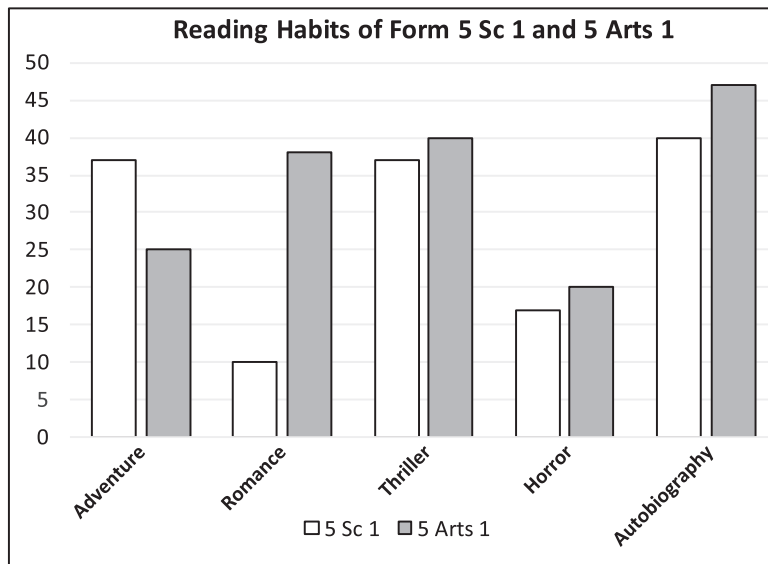

Osteoporosis is a common bone disease in which bones lose density and become more likely to fracture. It usually happens after the age of 50 and on average is six times more common in women than in men. The loss of bone density is accelerated during the postmenopausal period, partly due to the changes in hormone balance. It is also likely to occur in people who have low calcium intake. Exercising delays bone loss and promotes bone formation. Recommended exercises include lifting of weights and walking as little as four to six kilometres can help build our bone health.



- 1 Daniel, his wife, Sarah, and son, Adam were on a five-day camping trip in Taman Negara. On the third day, they rafted down Sungai Tahan. Heavy rains had turned the usually manageable falls into something fierce. As the three of them approached the falls late in the afternoon, Daniel could tell from the increasing roar of water that they were in serious trouble. There was no way they'd be able to rappel down the rocks as planned. 5
- 2 They could wade to the shore, but would anyone find them there? They had no cell service, and they hadn't seen a single person in the past three days. And Daniel knew that they'd be sharing the ground there with rattlesnakes and tigers.
- 3 Daniel heard voices coming from the other side of the falls. He yelled, but the sound of the rushing water drowned him out. "We have to get these people a message", he thought. He grabbed a stick and pulled out his pocketknife to carve "Help" on it. Then he tied a rope to it so the people would know it wasn't just any stick. He tried tossing it over the falls, but it floated away in the wrong direction. He had to try something else. Luckily, he spotted his green water bottle. He carved "HELP" on the bottle. Sarah reminded him that he had a pen and paper, which she'd brought to play games with, in his backpack. He scrawled "We are stuck here at the waterfall. Get help please" and shoved the note into the bottle. This time, his throw over the waterfall was perfect. 10 15
- 4 It was starting to get dark. They made a fire and laid out a tarp. To help the rescuers spot them, they spelled out "SOS" in white rocks, which they set on the blue tarp. As the evening wore on, they placed a headlamp with a flashing light on a ledge so that the SOS could be seen from overhead. Before turning in, Daniel stoked the fire to keep the tigers away. 20
- 5 Then, just after midnight, they heard a helicopter hovering above them. Daniel turned to his son and started shaking him. "They're here!" he said. Daniel ran over to the headlamp and started flashing it at the helicopter. He, Sarah and Adam were waving and hollering when they heard the magic words: "This is Search and Rescue. You have been found." The helicopter circled as the pilot looked for a good place to land. Finding none, the crew announced to the campers over the PA system that they would not be rescued until morning and told them to conserve their firewood. 25
- 6 The next morning, the helicopter returned and lowered a crew member on a cable and the rescuers lifted Daniel, Sarah, and Adam out of the gorge one by one and deposited them and their gear on the closest bank where the helicopter could safely land. It was a moment of pure happiness as the three chatted with the officers who had rescued them. Together, they marveled at the unlikelihood of it all. According to the rescuers, in the 25 years that they've been performing these kinds of rescues, no one's ever been rescued by a message in a bottle. 30 35
